We are seeking nominations for the Wrightsville Beach Museum Waterman Hall of Fame Class of 2019. Deadline for submissions is September 13, 2019. The class of inductees will be announced on September 20. The Celebration and Inductions to be held, on Sunday, October 20, 1 PM – 4 PM, Flamingo Ballroom, Blockade Runner Beach Resort, 275 Waynick Blvd., Wrightsville Beach, NC 28480.

In Remembrance: Please inform us of any waterman who passed away in 2019 to be included in the Remembrance Wreath Ceremony at the Induction.

This award was created to reflect the importance of community spirit and personal contributions to the culture of water sports and professions throughout the history of Wrightsville Beach. We wish to celebrate watermen and women who represent sportsmanship both in and out of the water. Those we recognize with this award exemplify the best of Wrightsville Beach in their character, demeanor, and spirit - both in competition and in their respect for the community.

The Wrightsville Beach Waterman Hall of Fame is intended to be a lasting tribute for the achievements of the generations of Wrightsville Beach watermen and waterwomen who have shaped this community and its relationship with the water. Wrightsville Beach was established because of its beauty and the lure of its ocean and marshes as a place to fish, sail, swim and recreate on and in the water. The values exhibited by the best of those who have made this their home based on that relationship with the water are to be embodied in the Hall of Fame.

The Wrightsville Beach Waterman Hall of Fame awards are selected by the Wrightsville Beach Waterman Hall of Fame Board comprising of members of the Wrightsville Beach Museum Board of Directors and community participants who represent a cross-section of those who have been a part of Wrightsville Beach water sports throughout the decades. There will be an emphasis on diversity of generations and sports within the Hall of Fame.

We will select up to 7 inductees from a combination of the following categories each year:

- **Surfing**
- **Fishing/Boating**
- **Sailing**
- **Ocean Rescue / Swimming**
- **Diving**

The Inductees should adhere to and/or reflect at least one of the following criteria:

Pioneer - Based on achieved fame as respected watermen/waterwomen or pioneers in the time before major championships; candidates must have reached the age of fifty years old or are deceased.

Champions -Must have held National Championship and/or National-Class event titles

Beach Culture –Nominated from the arts and/or administration field and must have helped create or define beach culture. Categories: Fashion, Art, Music, Equipment, Literature, Film Administration, Photography, and Acting.

Local Hero -Resided 10 years in New Hanover County Beaches or vicinity and were finalists in championships in categories of Champions, contributed to New Hanover County Beaches Water Culture, or were Pioneers in the Town.

Honor Roll -The Honor Roll was created to honor those individuals who have contributed to water sports and its culture and are deserving of recognition, but might not qualify in other categories.

Special Recognition – The Special Recognition was created to honor those individuals who have contributed to waterman activities and its culture, and can demonstrate roots in New Hanover County, but live currently outside New Hanover County.

Requirements for/Responsibilities of NOMINATORS:

Nominators are required to submit completed Nomination Forms by September 13, 2019. Nominators are required to be present at the inductions ceremony or designate an Alternate Nominator to fulfill their responsibilities, if they cannot be present. Nominators are required to introduce the inductee, present the achievements and contributions at the podium. Nominators (5 min) and Inductees (10 min) have a total of 15 minutes to present at the podium. The Chair of the event is the official timekeeper. Attire is casual or dressy casual. Nominators are required to submit 3 – 5 preferably high- resolution jpg digital images within 2 weeks of the selection announcement. Nominators are required to convert print images to digital images at a commercial vendor. Digital images may be delivered by email or thumb drive. Captions and approximate dates are encouraged. Contact the museum if you need help with this.
